

15 years of the Philadelphia Orchard Project: POP's Annual Orchard Celebration, September 17, 2022



On behalf of Philadelphia Orchard Project (POP), we would like to invite you to partner with us to commemorate **POP's 15th year** at our annual Orchard Celebration. This year's event is scheduled for Saturday, September 17 at the POP Learning Orchard at The Woodlands in West Philadelphia. #### Who We Are

POP is a nonprofit organization whose mission is to plant and support community orchards in the city of Philadelphia. The organization has planted 50 orchards in partnership with community groups across the city including schools, community gardens, houses of worship and other nonprofits. POP supports a total of 66 city orchards, providing partners with orchard design assistance, plant materials, volunteer recruitment and training in ecological orchard care. Community partners maintain, harvest and distribute the produce within their neighborhoods with ongoing training and support from POP. Since its founding in 2007, POP has provided financial assistance to two-thirds of its partners, contributing some or all of the costs for orchard design, plant materials, tools and education.

## What is the Orchard Celebration?

POP is planning its seventh annual fall event, now called the Orchard Celebration, in September 2022. This open house-style event will be held at POP's headquarters at The Woodlands, a National Historic Landmark in West Philadelphia. The day's events will include orchard and nursery tours, refreshments including fresh cider pressing and fruit and nut samples grown in POP community orchards, live music and an award ceremony recognizing this year's recipients of the Golden Persimmon and Purple Fig.
